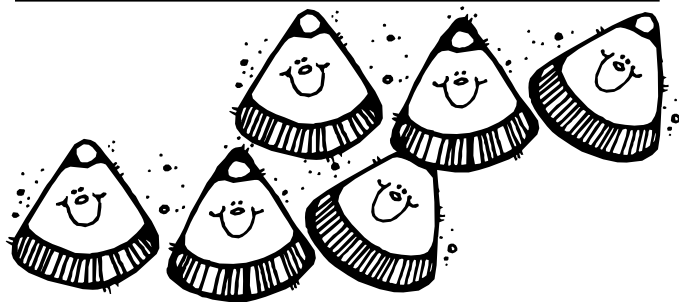


Reading Workshop

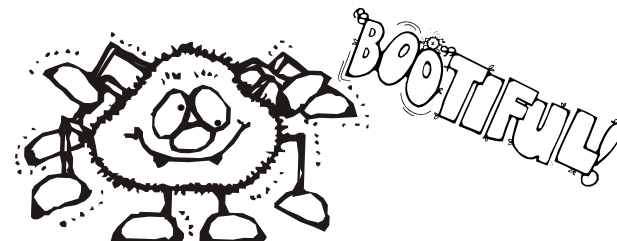
Math Concepts Covered
