Math Concepts Covered

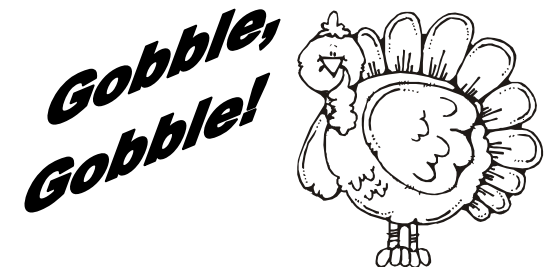
- + Students will continue to explore both 2-D and 3-D shapes. We will focus on rectangles this week. Students will be assessed on Unit 2 this week as well.
