

## Reading Workshop

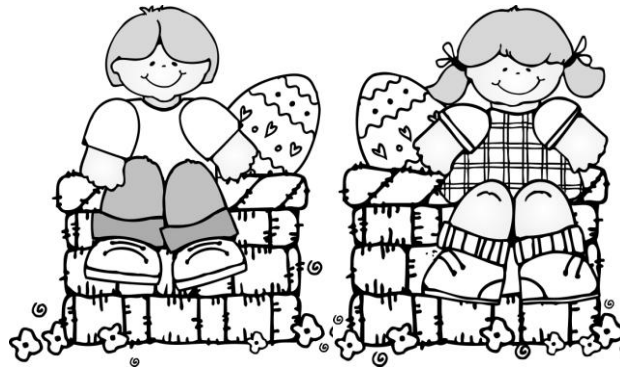
- ☞ We will continue our “cross-text” comparisons this week.
