- ☞ We will also be reading to gain information for our bat research.

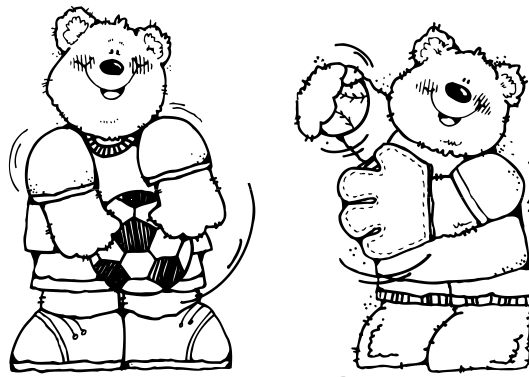
Social Studies

1. **Drop e:** make + ing = making
2. **y to i:** cry + ed = cried
3. **double final consonant:**
run + ing = running
4. **no change:** jump + ing = jumping
