## **Guidelines for School Calendar**

Section 1. <u>General</u>. The responsibility to adopt a school calendar rests entirely with the Board of School Trustees. In order for the Board of School Trustees of the East Allen County Schools to effect and adopt a calendar that is in the best interests of the children of the corporation, educational guidelines are desired which will assist the Administration in meeting this task.

Section 2. <u>Guidelines</u>. The following guidelines will be used by Administration in making their decision on the adoption of a school calendar:

- 1. Parents and students will be better able to prepare for school when the opening of school procedure is somewhat uniform from year to year.
- 2. Whenever possible, student attendance in any given week should be at least three (3) days.
- 3. Little educational value can be derived from student attendance on December 24th; therefore, whenever possible this should be a vacation day.
- 4. Due to Parent/teacher conference days and the lack of any breaks during the second semester, some form of spring vacation is desirable. In the event that a full week of spring vacation is possible, attempts should be made to structure this into the calendar on a regularly scheduled basis.
- 5. The calendar shall observe the following holidays without pay to certificated personnel: Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, and Memorial Day.
- 6. The calendar shall consist of a minimum of 185 teacher days.
- 7. Representatives of all employee groups will be given an opportunity to review the calendar and make recommendations to the Administration before its adoption by the Board.
- 8. The calendar will be presented to the Board in February of each calendar year with adoption no later than the second meeting in March of each calendar year.
