Apple Accessibility Support

Apple products have built-in accessibility options, including:

- Voice Control: navigate and interact with your device by using your voice to tap, swipe, type, and more.
- Switch Control: use a switch to select an item or location on your iOS device's screen, then choose an action to perform.
- Guided Access: gives control over potential distractions. For example, you can turn off your device's keyboard to prevent accidental input.

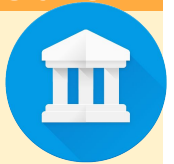

Skylert-Skyward

Guardians can now update their phone numbers and emails in Skylert—a new option in Skyward. To access, log into Skyward Family Access and click on the Skylert Tile. Select Phone Contacts or Email Contacts to verify or update each contact. You also have the ability to select which type of communication you would like to receive at each contact.

Note: Emergency notifications cannot be disabled for the Primary Guardian contact information.
