- A special shout-out to the positive male role models also known as a "Few Good Men" that welcomed back the **Southwick Elementary School** students after Spring Break!
- **Woodlan Elementary School** students and staff raised over \$1,500 for Pennies for Patients to help fight the battle against Leukemia and Lymphoma.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

- **Cedarville Elementary School - Addition**
The terrazzo flooring in the corridor in the new building is to be laid next week. Masons have started rubbing and patching the walls. The unit ventilators and the exhaust ductwork has been installed. The switch from temporary to permanent power occurred.
- **Heritage/Leo - Outbuildings**
At Heritage: the punch list for the baseball/softball building is scheduled for by April 27th.
- **Leo Elementary - Renovations/Additions**
During the next two weeks: the water membrane and brick veneer in the gym is to start; the elevated Mezzanine is to be poured; and continue prep work for the gym slab.
- **New Haven High School - Renovations/Addition**
Work continues on: the overhead MEP installations in the main gym and upper gym areas along with the painting of the walls and ceiling deck; the initial installation of the railing and glass along the 2nd floor of the gym has occurred with finishing work yet to be done; the installation of masonry on the auxiliary gym, mechanical room, and second floor of the classroom addition continues. Roof work has begun on the Administrative addition..
- **New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction**
Work continues on the installation of the masonry walls in the classroom addition. The installation of the storm line on the south side of the building continues. The interior footings for the three stairwells have been poured.
- **Paul Harding Junior High/East Allen University**
The demo of the furniture and fixtures in the two large group instruction classrooms occurred.
- **Southwick Elementary School - Renovations/Additions**
The masonry wall on the first floor of the elevator addition is complete. The elevator shaft is complete to beam bearing elevation. The laying of the toilet chase walls in the first floor addition has begun. The interior masonry walls in the classrooms and corridor have been painted. The unit ventilators have been set in place in the classrooms.
- **Turf Fields**
Preliminary construction work at Heritage and Woodlan is to start on April 16th.
- **Woodlan Outbuilding**
The installation of the interior masonry walls is complete. The coiling counter doors, stainless counters, and the exterior doors and overhead door have been installed. Work has begun on hanging the interior doors. The storm line that runs through the parking lot has been installed.
