IN THE NEWS:

- **East Allen Alternative School's** LINX program students have been volunteering for Georgetown Community Little League - fixing sinks and picnic tables, hanging banners, getting the facilities ready for Opening Day; they've made it possible for games to be played instead of being rained out!
- **East Allen University** has 52 students on track to earn their Associate Degree from Vincennes University. That means over 79% of the senior class has earned 60 plus college credits while in high school.

- **Three Leo Jr./Sr. High School** students won the Omnisource/Allen County Public Library's "Trash to Treasure" Art Contest. Shelby Tackett won 1st place (\$100), Claire Buchheit won 2nd place (\$50), and Aerin Goldman won 3rd place (\$25).
- **New Haven High Schools'** recent ISSMA results: Their Band received silver, Advanced Choir received gold, and Vocal Jazz received gold with a special gold distinction pin for sightreading!
- Congratulations to all **New Haven Middle School** students who qualified for Flying Aces for each "A" earned and no referrals. Congratulations to Trisha Mitchell being name NHMS Teacher of the Year, as well as EACS' Secondary Teacher of the Year.
- On April 23rd **Paul Harding Junior High** students, teachers and staff participated in numerous community service projects. Students provided assistance at 5 area churches, 3 Community Centers, 4 schools, The Community Harvest Food Bank, YMCA, and Lutheran Life Villages.
- Several **Woodlan High School** Anthis students competed in the Skills USA state competition in Indianapolis. Cole Koenig placed 2nd in Masonry; Noah Funk and Matt Singer competed.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

Cedarville Elementary School - Addition

The corridor slab for the terrazzo has begun to be poured. In the next two weeks: tile flooring in restrooms laid; the grinding of the terrazzo flooring in the corridor; start the installation of ceiling grid; and start the laying of face brick and split face block. Substantial completion date is July 27, 2018.

Heritage/Leo - Outbuildings

Passed all inspections (plumbing, HVAC, electrical, structural) and EACS is able to utilize the baseball/softball buildings at Heritage and Leo. The punch list for the baseball/softball buildings at Heritage & Leo occurred the issues are being addressed.

Leo Elementary - Renovations/Additions

The elevated Mezzanine was poured and started to lay the brick veneer on the south wall of the gym. In the next two weeks will continue the laying of brick veneer on the gym walls and start to prep for the pour of the slab in the gym.

New Haven High School - Renovations/Addition

Painting of the ceiling deck and install of LED lights in the main gym is complete. Ceiling tile and grid have been removed in the corridors. The installation of masonry on the auxiliary gym, mechanical room, and second floor of the classroom addition continues.

New Haven Intermediate School - New Construction

Existing storm and sanitary lines under the new building location were removed. The south exterior foundation wall of Unit A (office area) was poured. The interior footings in Unit C (classrooms) are almost complete. The north and west exterior masonry walls in Unit C are up to second floor bearing height.

Southwick Elementary School - Renovations/Additions

The concrete block interior/exterior walls of the elevator addition is complete. The ceiling grid has been installed in all classrooms. In the next two weeks work to occur includes: paint door frames; complete ceiling grid at unit ventilators, begin the installation of elevator, start the pour of the terrazzo in the classroom addition corridor, and install window sills and classroom marker/tack boards.

Turf Fields

The site demo work which involves the removal of the goals posts, flag poles, interior runways/pads for track events, and soil "spoils" at Heritage and Woodlan has started.

Woodlan Outbuilding

The site sanitary sewer line has been installed. The utility and storage rooms were painted with block filler and two finish coats. Started installation of the locker rooms exhaust fans. Switched from temporary to permanent power. In the next two weeks: start ceiling grid and site concrete; set the furnaces in place and connect ductwork; complete the electrical overhead rough-ins. Substantial Completion Date is July 1, 2018.
