SPOTLIGHT ON OUR TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

Each year the Transportation Department tries to identify areas of concern for our students, and we then work hard to address those issues.

This year one of the new changes comes in the form of a new parent app from Edulog that helps our parents locate the bus on route to and from the school. Parents are able to set the time for notification for the app letting the parent know when the bus is 5 minutes away or 20 minutes away depending on the needs of the parent. This new app can be found on the EACS website under the Transportation tab.

A second new feature to our busses this year is the use of Samsara tablets for bus GPS. This updated feature allows the driver the ability to receive driving directions the same as many of us utilize Smart phones for directions in our vehicles. The tablets are mounted in a location that allows the drivers to remain hands-free while performing their driving duties. This new GPS also grants us the ability to track our buses and monitor all engine codes bettering the servicing of our busses day in and day out.
