THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES

The EACS Board of School Trustees is composed of seven members. These members are elected to a 4-year term. School Board elections are conducted in November along with the general elections. Board members are seated on January 1st.

Board meetings typically take place on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday's of the month at 6:30 p.m. and are held at the EACS Administration Building in the Board Room. The public is welcome to attend these meetings.

Indiana law also allows the Board to meet in private Executive Sessions to discuss certain personnel, legal and negotiation matters.

The Board's primary duties are to:

- Set and amend school policy
- Provide, by means of a tax levy, the physical facilities and funds necessary for the operation of the schools within the district
- Select and employ a superintendent
- Appraise the worth and effectiveness of the educational program, and
- Help interpret the educational program to the community
